MINISTER NOSIVIWE MAPISA-NQAKULA JOINS THE OFFICIAL DELEGATION TO THE UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY (UNGA) AT UN HEADQUARTERS IN NEW YORK, USA

The Minister of Defence and Military Veterans, Hon Nosiviwe Mapisa-Nqakula - MP, will join world leaders and representatives from 193 UN member states at the 69th session of the UN General Assembly (UNGA 69) as part of the South African delegation.

The theme for the 69th UNGA session is 'Delivering on and Implementing a Transformative Post-2015 Development Agenda.' Member states will comment on the theme during the General Debate on Wednesday, 24 September 2014.

The 69th session will cover a wide range of topics of global concern from development to security, and from the promotion of human rights to the protection of justice and international law.

The President of the General Assembly, Sam Kutesa convened the first plenary meeting on Tuesday, 16 September 2014.
