MILITARY POLICE ARRESTS THREE SUSPECTS ON FRAUD AND CORRUPTION ALLEGATIONS

Three suspects were arrested on Monday, 01 August 2016 in Potchefstroom, following lengthy investigations by Military Police Division of the South African National Defence Force (SANDF) on activities of fraud and corruption. The alleged crimes occurred in 2008 at Army Support Base (ASB) Potchefstroom when a company received a tender to erect security fence around the base.

Two of the three suspects are employees of the company which rendered service at that time to ASB Potchefstroom and the third suspect is a senior officer in the SANDF, who works at the same base. The suspects appeared in the Pretoria Commercial Crimes Court on Tuesday, 02 August 2016 and were granted bail.
