UPDATE: THEFT OF MILITARY EQUIPMENT AT THE SA NAVY ARMAMENT DEPOT

Following a break-in at the SA Navy Armament Depot (SANAD) on the weekend of 23 July 2016, a collaborative effort and speedy response by the Military Police and HAWKS have led to the arrest of two suspects who illegally accessed and trespassed the SANAD. After their arrest, these suspects led both the Military Police and HAWKS to where the stolen military equipment was stored. All the stolen equipment was recovered.

The investigation, which is currently underway, may lead to more arrests.
