Most recently, the squadron celebrated the achievement of having the first black female qualify as a Commander of C130 Hercules Aircraft.

The Squadron has been actively involved in United Nations and African Union peacekeeping missions in various countries such as Burundi, Sudan, Central African Republic and Democratic Republic of Congo.

Some of the highlights of 28 Squadron includes the flying of the mortal remains of the late President Nelson Rolihlahla Mandela to his ancestral home in the Eastern Cape and undertook numerous flights in support of Operation Uxolo. It also provided the ceremonial flag which was used to drape the former president's casket on the journey from Houghton to the mortuary in Pretoria.
